

**TOWN OF PROVOST IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

**BYLAW NO # 09/2011**

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE COUNCIL, OF THE TOWN OF PROVOST TO AMEND BYLAW NO # 02/2007, BEING THE TOWN OF PROVOST PUBLIC PLACES BYLAW.**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Town of Provost deems it desirable to amend Bylaw 02/2007, being the Public Places Bylaw.

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PROVOST ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

**1. Section 2.2**

**2.2 (yy)** is to read “**Beyond maximum time posted**” means; a vehicle parked beyond the time indicated on the sign shall be considered as parking overtime and beyond the limit fixed and such overtime parking shall constitute an offence under this chapter

**2. Section 9**

**9.1 (u)** is to read: “**Two hour parking-maximum- street-location** ” means; parking at any one or more locations on any street or portion thereof listed in *Bylaw 03/2007 Traffic Control Devices Schedule 'A'* for a period or periods totalling more than two hours on any day is prohibited,




**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the town of Provost duly assembles enacts as follows:

2. This bylaw shall come into force and effect upon third and final passage.
